The Sabetha Parks and Recreation Department will have openings for qualified and dedicated individuals to do umpiring for the youth summer leagues. There will also be positions for lifeguards and park maintenance personnel.

## OTHER ACTIVITIES

**Midtown** - The gym is available for anyone wanting to play basketball or for walking on cold or rainy days. It is also used for adult sports and youth practices. The gym can be rented out for events by the hour or by the day. Fee is \$8/hr. or \$40 for the day.

**Fitness Center** - this area is located within the Midtown building. It is outfitted with elliptical machines, treadmills, free weights, and other equipment to help you stay healthy. Single memberships are only \$30 or \$40 for family memberships for the entire year. These can be purchased at City Hall.

**The Great Outdoors** - Sabetha Pony Creek Lake offers various outdoor recreational activities. These include but are not limited to fishing, camping, and picnicking. Shelter houses are located around the lake. In addition, the Old Sabetha Lake is the spot for boating, water skiing, and jet skiing.
