ORDINANCE \_\_\_\_\_

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING IN PART PORTIONS OF THE CURRENT CODE OF THE CITY OF SABETHA, KANSAS, AND ORDINANCE #1461 REGULATING AND ESTABLISHING LOCAL TRAFFIC REGULATIONS WITHIN THE CORPORATE LIMITS OF THE CITY OF SABETHA, KANSAS.

Be it ordained by the Governing Body of the City of Sabetha, Kansas:

Section 1. That Section 14-220, Chapter XIV, Article 2. of the Code of the City of Sabetha and Ordinance #1461 are hereby repealed and the following adopted in its place and stead, including any other provisions of said City Code which are inconsistent with the provisions herein.

Section 2. That Section 14-220 of the Code of the City of Sabetha shall read as follows:

Section 14-220. NO PARKING ZONE. There are hereby established "No Parking" zones, in which there shall be no parking of any motor vehicles, on the following streets:

(a) On both the east and west sides of Eighth Street, between Main and Grant Streets, except as follows:

1. Handicap parking in designated areas; and,
2. Sundays, when parallel parking shall be allowed on both sides of said portion of Eighth Street, when done in a fashion so as not to block alleys, driveways, or obstruction to fire plug in the area.

(b) On the east side of South 13<sup>th</sup> street between Virginia Street and Dakota Street.

(c) On the north side of Grant Street between 4<sup>th</sup> Street and 5<sup>th</sup> Street.

(d) On both sides of 14<sup>th</sup> Street between Main Street to Oregon Street.

Anyone who parks in violation of the No Parking zones as the same are herein established commits an unlawful act in violation of Section 96 of the Standard Traffic Ordinance (STO), as the same now exists or is hereafter amended, and shall be subject to penalties in accordance with Section 201 of the STO.

Section 3. That this ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after its publication once in the official city newspaper.

AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND CHAPTER 14, ARTICLE 2 OF THE CODE OF THE CITY OF SABETHA TO DECREASE MAXIMUM SPEED LIMITS PURSUANT TO K.S.A. 8-1560 and 8-2001, ET SEQ..

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE CITY OF SABETHA, KANSAS, as follows:

1. That the Code of the City of Sabetha is hereby amended by adopting a revised section 14-219, which reads as follows:

14-219 RESIDENTIAL SPEED ZONES. The Chief Law Enforcement Officer of the City of Sabetha has determined, based upon a traffic investigation, that the speed limit as provided by law upon certain streets within the city limits of the City of Sabetha is more than what is reasonable or safe under the residential conditions found to exist, and he has determined and declared a reasonable and safe speed limit thereon to be twenty (20) miles per hour on those designated streets and has erected appropriate signs giving notice thereof; therefore, the speed limit on the following described streets is hereby set at twenty (20) miles per hour:

(i) that part of Roosevelt Street west from Paramount Street;

(ii) that part of Sixth Street north from Lincoln Street to Berwick Road; and

(iii) that part of Timberlane Drive from the intersection of Utah Street, then southwesterly through the curve 850 feet.

2. This ordinance shall be published once in the official City newspaper and upon such publication, shall be in full force and effect.

Be it ordained by the Governing Body of the City of Sabetha, Kansas:

Section 1. That Section 14-220, Chapter XIV, Article 2. of the Code of the City of Sabetha is hereby repealed and the following adopted in its place and stead, including any other provisions of said City Code which are inconsistent with the provisions herein.

Section 2. That Section 14-220 of the Code of the City of Sabetha shall read as follows:

Section 14-220. NO PARKING ZONE. There are hereby established "No Parking" zones, in which there shall be no parking of any motor vehicles, on the following streets:

(a) On both the east and west sides of Eighth Street, between Main and Grant Streets, except as follows:

1. Handicap parking in designated areas; and,
2. Sundays, when parallel parking shall be allowed on both sides of said portion of Eighth Street, when done in a fashion so as not to block alleys, driveways, or obstruction the fire plug in the area.

(b) On both east and west sides of South 13<sup>th</sup> street between Virginia and Dakota Streets.

Anyone who parks in violation of the No Parking zones as the same are herein established commits an unlawful act in violation of Section 96 of the Standard Traffic Ordinance (STO), as the same now exists or is hereafter amended, and shall be subject to penalties in accordance with Section 201 of the STO.

Section 3. That this ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after its publication once in the official city newspaper.

AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND CHAPTER 14, ARTICLE 2 OF THE CODE OF THE CITY OF SABETHA TO DESIGNATE A STREET AND ESTABLISH MAXIMUM SPEED LIMITS PURSUANT TO K.S.A. 8-1560 and 8-2001, ET SEQ..

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE CITY OF SABETHA, KANSAS, as follows:

1. That the Code of the City of Sabetha is hereby amended by adopting Section 14-222, which reads as follows:

14-222 MAIN STREET DESIGNATION. a) That the street which begins at the east boundary line of old U.S. Highway 75 and Main Street and running thence easterly, thence southerly, thence easterly to the east boundary line of the intersection of new U.S. Highway 75 and 270<sup>th</sup> Road is hereby designated as "Main Street" and appropriate signs giving notice thereof shall be erected.

b) That a speed limit of 30 miles per hour shall be in effect for that portion of Main Street which begins at the east boundary line of old U.S. Highway 75 and Main Street and running thence easterly, thence southerly, thence easterly to the east boundary line of the intersection of new U.S. Highway 75 and 270<sup>th</sup> Road.

(c) That all other speed zones previously ordained for Main Street within the City of Sabetha shall remain in full force and effect, except as modified herein.

2. This ordinance shall be published once in the official City newspaper and upon such publication, shall be in full force and effect.

AN ORDINANCE REGULATING TRAFFIC WITHIN THE CORPORATE LIMITS OF THE CITY OF SABETHA, KANSAS; INCORPORATING BY REFERENCE THE "STANDARD TRAFFIC ORDINANCE FOR KANSAS CITIES" EDITION OF 2004, WITH CERTAIN OMISSIONS, CHANGES AND ADDITIONS; PROVIDING CERTAIN PENALTIES AND REPEALING ORDINANCE 1380.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE CITY OF SABETHA, KANSAS:

Section 1. INCORPORATING STANDARD TRAFFIC ORDINANCE. There is hereby incorporated by reference for the purpose of regulating traffic within the corporate limits of the City of Kansas, that certain standard traffic ordinance known as the "Standard Traffic Ordinance for Kansas Cities," Edition of 2004, prepared and published in book form by the League of Kansas Municipalities, Topeka, Kansas, No fewer than three copies of said Standard Traffic Ordinance shall be marked or stamped "Official Copy as Adopted by Ordinance No. \_\_\_\_\_" and to which shall be attached a copy of this ordinance, and filed with the city clerk to be open to inspection and available to the public at all reasonable hours. The police department, municipal judge and all administrative departments of the city charged with enforcement of the ordinance shall be supplied, at the cost of the city, such number of official copies of such Standard Traffic Ordinance similarly marked, as may be deemed expedient.

Section 2. TRAFFIC INFRACTIONS AND TRAFFIC OFFENSES.

(A) An ordinance traffic infraction is a violation of any section of this ordinance that prescribes or requires the same behavior as that prescribed or required by a statutory provision that is classified as a traffic infraction in K.S.A. 8-2118.

(B) All traffic violations which are included within this ordinance, and which are not ordinance traffic infractions, as defined in subsection (a) of this section, shall be considered traffic offenses.

Section 3. PENALTY FOR SCHEDULED FINES. The fine for violation of an ordinance traffic infraction or any other traffic offense for which the municipal judge establishes a fine in a fine schedule shall not be less than \$10.00 nor more than \$1,000.00 A person tried and convicted for violation of an ordinance traffic infraction or other traffic offense for which a fine has been established in a schedule of fines shall pay a fine fixed by the court not to exceed \$500.

Section 4. All local traffic regulations as set forth in Article 2 of Chapter 14 of the Code of the City of Sabetha shall remain in full force and effect and shall not be effected by the implementation of this Standard Traffic Ordinance, but shall be supplemental and in addition thereto.

Section 5. REPEAL. Ordinance number 1380 is repealed.

Section 6. EFFECTIVE DATE. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after its publication in The Sabetha Herald.

AN ORDINANCE REGULATING TRAFFIC WITHIN THE CORPORATE LIMITS OF THE CITY OF SABETHA, KANSAS MAKING THE USE OF CERTAIN MECHANICAL EXHAUST BRAKING DEVICES UNLAWFUL IN THE CITY OF SABETHA; AND PROVIDING FOR A PENALTY FOR VIOLATION OF ORDINANCE;

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE CITY OF SABETHA, KANSAS:

Section 1. USE OF MECHANICAL EXHAUST BRAKING DEVICE UNLAWFUL. It shall be unlawful for the driver of any vehicle to use or operate or cause to be used or operated within the City any mechanical exhaust device designed to aid in the braking or deceleration of any vehicle which results in the excessive, loud, unusual or explosive noise from such vehicle.

Section 2. PENALTY. The penalty for violation of this ordinance shall be the general penalty as set out in Section. 1-116 of the Code of the City of Sabetha, as amended.

Section 3. PLACEMENT IN CITY CODE. This ordinance shall be come part of Article 2 of Chapter 14 of the Code of the City of Sabetha.

Section 4. EFFECTIVE DATE. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after its publication in The Sabetha Herald.

AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND CHAPTER 14, ARTICLE 2 OF THE CODE OF THE CITY OF SABETHA TO DEFINE STREETS OR HIGHWAYS PURSUANT TO THE UNIFORM TRAFFIC OFFENSE CODE OF THE CITY OF SABETHA, KANSAS

WHEREAS, the owner of certain real property more fully described below has requested the enforcement of city traffic ordinances on private property; and,

WHEREAS, the governing body of the City of Sabetha finds that enforcement of city traffic ordinances on this tract of private property will promote the health, safety, and well-being of the citizens of the City of Sabetha, Kansas.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE CITY OF SABETHA, KANSAS, as follows:

1. That the Code of the City of Sabetha is hereby amended by adopting a definition for streets or highways, as that definition appears in the Uniform Traffic Offense Code, adopted by Ordinance 1406, which reads as follows:

"Streets" or "highways" shall mean the entire width between the boundary lines of every way publicly maintained when any part thereof is open to the use of the public for purposes of vehicular traffic, to include without limitation, all that roadway described as beginning at the southwest corner of Outlot 33 in the Northwest Quarter (NW $\frac{1}{4}$ ) of Section 1, Township 2 South, Range 14 East, Nemaha County, Kansas, thence northerly to a point on the north line of said Northwest Quarter, thence west 35 feet, thence southerly to a point on the north boundary line of Lincoln Street, thence east 35 feet to the point of beginning.

2. This ordinance shall be published once in the official City newspaper and upon such publication, shall be in full force and effect.

AN ORDINANCE REGULATING TRAFFIC WITHIN THE CORPORATE LIMITS OF THE CITY OF SABETHA, KANSAS TO REGULATE THE OPERATION OF ALL-TERRAIN VEHICLES IN THE CITY OF SABETHA; AND PROVIDING FOR A PENALTY FOR VIOLATION OF ORDINANCE

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE CITY OF SABETHA, KANSAS:

Section 1. OPERATION OF ALL-TERRAIN VEHICLES UNLAWFUL. (a) It shall be unlawful for any person to operate an all-terrain vehicle on any street, highway, alley or other public right-of-way within the city limits of the City of Sabetha, Kansas, except as provided in subsection (b) set out below.

(b) Notwithstanding the provisions of subsection (a); all-terrain vehicles operated as an implement of husbandry or for snow and ice removal, which operation on the streets and alleys is incidental to its operation in such capacity, shall be permitted.

(c) No all-terrain vehicle shall be operated on any street, highway, alley, or other public right-of-way within the city limits of the City of Sabetha between sunset and sunrise unless equipped with lights as required by law for motorcycles.

Section 2. PENALTY. The penalty for violation of this ordinance shall be the general penalty as set out in Section. 1-116 of the Code of the City of Sabetha, as amended.

Section 3. PLACEMENT IN CITY CODE. This ordinance shall become part of Article 2 of Chapter 14 of the Code of the City of Sabetha.

Section 4. EFFECTIVE DATE. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after its publication in The Sabetha Herald.

AN ORDINANCE REGULATING TRAFFIC WITHIN THE CORPORATE LIMITS OF THE CITY OF SABETHA, KANSAS; INCORPORATING BY REFERENCE THE "STANDARD TRAFFIC ORDINANCE FOR KANSAS CITIES," EDITION OF 1997, WITH CERTAIN OMISSIONS, CHANGES AND ADDITIONS; PRESCRIBING ADDITIONAL REGULATIONS; PROVIDING CERTAIN PENALTIES AND REPEALING ORDINANCE NO. 1288.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE CITY OF SABETHA, KANSAS:

Section 1. **INCORPORATING STANDARD TRAFFIC ORDINANCE.** There is hereby incorporated by reference for the purpose of regulating traffic within the corporate limits of the City of Sabetha, Kansas, that certain standard traffic ordinance known as the "Standard Traffic Ordinance for Kansas Cities," Edition of 1997, prepared and published in book form by the League of Kansas Municipalities, Topeka, Kansas, save and except such articles, sections, parts or portions as are hereafter omitted, deleted, modified or changed. No fewer than three copies of said Standard Traffic Ordinance shall be marked or stamped "Official Copy as Adopted by Ordinance No. \_\_\_\_\_," with all sections or portions thereof intended to be omitted or changed clearly marked to show any such omission or change and to which shall be attached a copy of this ordinance, and filed with the city clerk to be open to inspection and available to the public at all reasonable hours. The police department, municipal judge and all administrative departments of the city charged with enforcement of the ordinance shall be supplied, at the cost of the city, such number of official copies of such Standard Traffic Ordinance similarly marked, as may be deemed expedient.

Section 2. **TRAFFIC INFRACTIONS AND TRAFFIC OFFENSES.**

- a) An ordinance traffic infraction is a violation of any section of this ordinance that prescribes or requires the same behavior as that prescribed or required by a statutory provision that is classified as a traffic infraction in K.S.A. 8-2118.
- b) All traffic violations which are included within this ordinance, and which are not ordinance traffic infractions, as defined in subsection (a) of this section, shall be considered traffic offenses.

Section 3. **PENALTY FOR SCHEDULED FINES.** The fine for violation of an ordinance traffic infraction or any other traffic offense for which the municipal judge establishes a fine in a fine schedule shall not be less than \$10.00 no more than \$500.00. A person tried and convicted for violation of an ordinance traffic infraction or other traffic offense for which a fine has been established in a schedule of fines shall pay a fine fixed by the

court not to exceed \$500.00.

Section 4. **LOCAL REGULATIONS.** All local traffic regulations as set forth in Article 2 of Chapter 14 of the Code of the City of Sabetha shall remain in full force and effect and shall not be effected by the implementation of this Standard Traffic Ordinance, but shall be supplemental and in addition thereto.

Section 5. **REPEAL.** Ordinance No. 1288 is repealed.

Section 6. **EFFECTIVE DATE.** This ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after its publication in the official city newspaper.
