CEMETERY BOARD
SUBSIDY INCREASE
REQUEST

Scott Aberle and several members of the Cemetery Board were present to discuss with the Commission increasing the yearly subsidy and purchase of a mower. Discussion followed. Commissioner Nick Aberle made a motion to increase the yearly subsidy from \$24,000 per year to \$30,000 and to purchase a Grasshopper mower from Lang Diesel for \$7628.68. Commissioner Julie Burenheide seconded the motion. The motion carried 5 – 0.
