Approved minutes from the September 26, 2016 Commission meeting

CONDITIONAL USE
PERMIT – APOSTOLIC
CHRISTIAN FAITH
CHURCH

Commissioner Maridel Wittmer made a motion to approve the Conditional Use Permit #Z-CU-16-135 for Apostolic Christian Faith Church to construct a church, fellowship center and cemetery on land zoned as agricultural. Commissioner Nick Aberle seconded the motion. The motion carried 4 – 0.

POLICE REPORT

Police Chief Robert Wahwasuck was in attendance to discuss a recent dog complaint and provide the Commission with the monthly Police report. Police Chief Robert Wahwasuck admitted that the communication between the department and the victim failed, new procedures have been put in place to avoid this. Discussion followed. Chief Wahwasuck also advised the Commission that Officer Carolyn Clark had submitted her resignation. Discussion followed. Commissioner Maridel Wittmer expressed concern over individuals out for walks on the streets with limited visible clothing. Discussion followed. Commissioner Wittmer asked if the Officers could hand out reflective vests. Police Chief Robert Wahwasuck will check into the costs.

ORDINANCE #1514
LOUD AND EXCESSIVE
NOISE

Commissioner Julie Burenheide made a motion to approve Ordinance #1514. An ordinance amending in part portions of the current code of the City of Sabetha, regulating and prohibiting loud and excessive noises with the jurisdiction of the City of Sabetha. Commissioner Maridel Wittmer seconded the motion. The motion carried 4 – 0.

FALL BURN DATES

Mayor Doug Clark made motion to approve the Fall Burn dates from October 11th to November 28th. Commissioner Julie Burenheide seconded the motion. The motion carried 4 – 0.

COMPREHENSIVE PLAN
UPDATE

Mayor Doug Clark began discussion on the revised Comprehensive Plan. Commissioner Julie Burenheide asked that the stipulation that an Economic Development Director position be developed within 1 to 3 years be removed. Discussion followed. Commissioner Nick Aberle made a motion to approve the Comprehensive Plan as presented by the Planning Commission. Commissioner Maridel Wittmer seconded the motion. The motion carried 3 – 1. Commissioner Julie Burenheide voted against the motion.
